

Negligence leads to death of 7 deer

In a sad incident, 5 spotted deer were killed while being shifted from Nelapattu Birds Sanctuary to the forest area in Rapur of Nellore district because of alleged negligence of wildlife officials on Wednesday.

According to information, forest officials have brought 8 blackbucks to the bird sanctuary from the Zoo in Tirupati on Tuesday and decided to shift 15 spotted deer to Seshachalam forest area near Rajampeta as their number is on the raise.

A veterinary doctor from Tirupati forest wing administered sedation to the spotted deer to transfer them to Rajampeta on Tuesday evening to enable forest officials to shift them. However, two deer died while the labour hired by

the department tried to catch them.

Forest officials buried the two dead deer in the sanctuary and shifted 6 deer including a female deer they managed to carry to Rajampeta.

However, except the female deer five of them died by the time they reached Rajampeta. They left the deer in the forest and brought back the dead deer and buried them in the sanctuary.

The officials tried to conceal the incident but the incident came to light after they contacted some veterinary doctors to conduct post-mortem on Thursday.

When contacted, Tirupati Wildlife Management chief conservator Ravikumar confirmed the death of the deer and suspected shock as reason for their death. He said that he has ordered for post-mortem to find out the cause for the mortality.

2 die, 2 hurt in road accident

Two persons died and two others injured critically when a speeding car hit a stationary lorry on the national highway near Ulavapadu mandal in Prakasam district during the early hours of Friday.

The deceased and injured belong to Nellore and the mishap occurred when all the four were returning from Hyderabad in the ill-fated car.

The deceased have been identified as Rasani Srinivasulu, 50, and Venkateswarlu, 25, driver of the car and the injured as Dayakar and Khajal.

Police have shifted the injured to the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical sciences (RIMS) Hospital in Ongole for treatment.
